A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON JOINT COOPERATION SIGNED BETWEEN ISLAMIC MILITARY COUNTER TERRORISM COALITION (IMCTC) AND KING FAISAL CENTER FOR RESEARCH AND ISLAMIC STUDIES (KFCRIS)



## Riyadh, June 2, 2021

Within the framework of joint cooperation between the Islamic Military Counter Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC) and King Faisal Center for Research and Islamic Studies (KFCRIS), a memorandum of understanding on joint cooperation was signed today, June 2, 2021, between IMCTC, represented by the IMCTC Acting Secretary-General, Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi, and KFCRIS represented by the KFCRIS Acting Secretary-General H.E. Prof. Dr. Turki bin Muhammad Al-shuwaier.
