

IMCTC Secretary-General meets with Bahrain's Minister of Foreign Affairs at the sidelines of IISS Manama dialogue 2021

Bahrain's minister of foreign affairs, Dr. Abdullatif Al-Zayani, received in Manama, on Sunday, November 21, 2021, IMCTC's Secretary-General, Maj. Gen.
