

IMCTC Secretary-General meets with the Chief of Defense Staff of the Republic of the Gambia

The Secretary-General of the Islamic Military Counter-Terrorism Coalition, Maj. Gen. Mohammed Bin Saeed Al-Moghedi met with the Chief of Defense Staff of the Republic of the Gambia, Lt. Gen. Mamat O. Cham, in Banjul. Both sides discussed avenues of cooperation between IMCTC and the Republic of the Gambia. Lt. Gen. Cham was briefed on IMCTC's initiatives across its domains: ideology, communications, counter-terrorist financing, and military.

HE, Lt. Gen. Cham, welcomed Maj. Gen. Al-Moghedi and praised the IMCTC's efforts in serving member countries' interests in the fight against terrorism.
