

## IMCTC Secretary-General meets with the Foreign Secretary of People's Republic of Bangladesh

The Foreign Secretary of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Masud Bin Momen, received at the headquarters of the Bangladeshi Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Dhaka, on Tuesday, July 26, 2022, the Secretary-General of the Islamic Military Counter-Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC), Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi.

Over the course of the visit, both sides explored avenues of cooperation, shared visions and means of strengthening the relationships to realize the desired objectives in countering terrorism.
