

IMCTC receives the Chief of General Staff of Kuwait Armed Forces

In the presence of His Excellency, Chief of General Staff of the Saudi Armed Forces, Gen. Fayyad bin Hamed Al-Ruwaili, the Secretary-General of IMCTC, Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi, welcomed today His Excellency Lt. Gen.
