ISLAMIC MILITARY COUNTER TERRORISM COALITION (IMCTC) HOLDS A SYPOSIUM ENTITLED "SOURCES OF TERRORIST FINANCING AND COUNTERING METHODS"

The Islamic Military Counter Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC) held a symposium entitled "Sources of Terrorist Financing and Countering Methods", on Wednesday, 21 April 2021, at its headquarters in Riyadh. The symposium was presented by Col. Ibrahim Mousa, Delegate of the Republic of Niger to IMCTC, and Mr. Khalid Arab, Delegate of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan to IMCTC, and moderated by Col.
