The Islamic Military Counterterrorism Coalition organized, on Monday, 05-07-2021, at its headquarters in Riyadh, an event titled: “The Role of Emerging Technologies in the Early Detection of Radical Terrorist Content on Social Media Networks”, delivered by Dr. Majdal bin Sultan bin Safran, a ministerial advisor and artificial intelligence expert.
